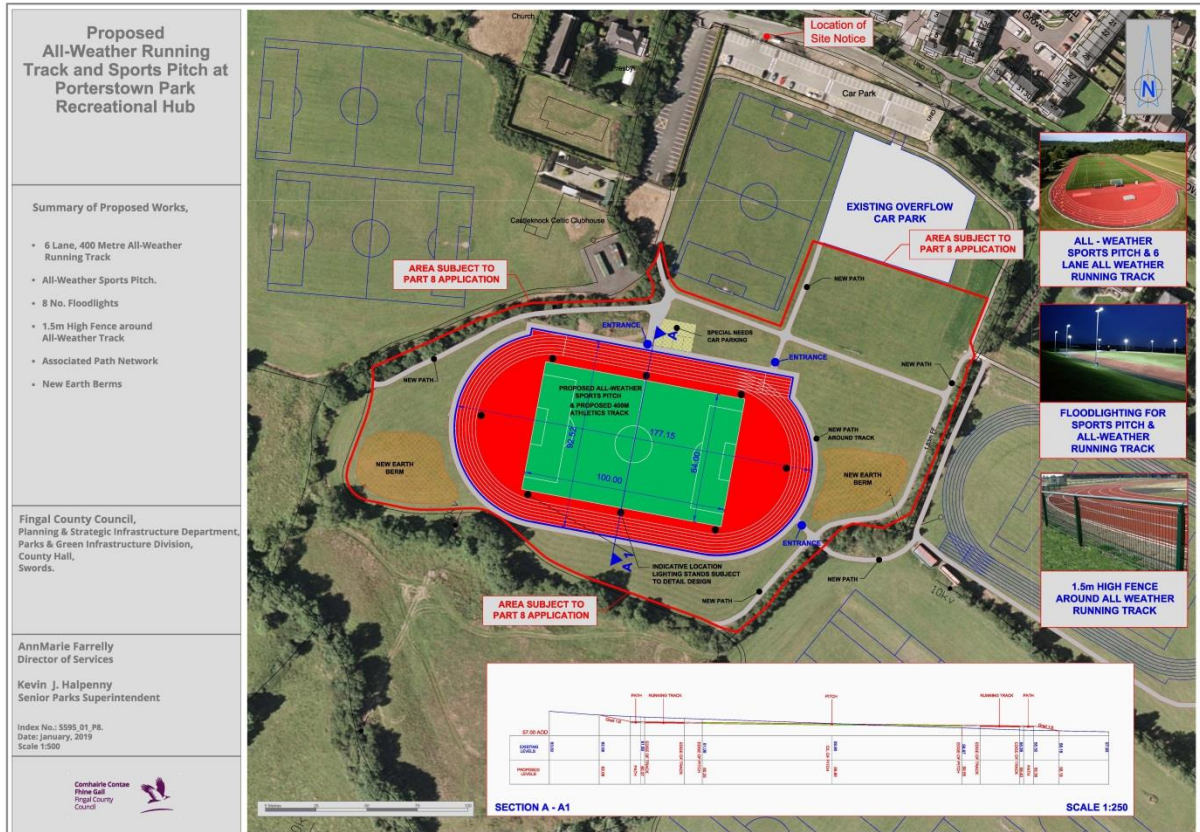

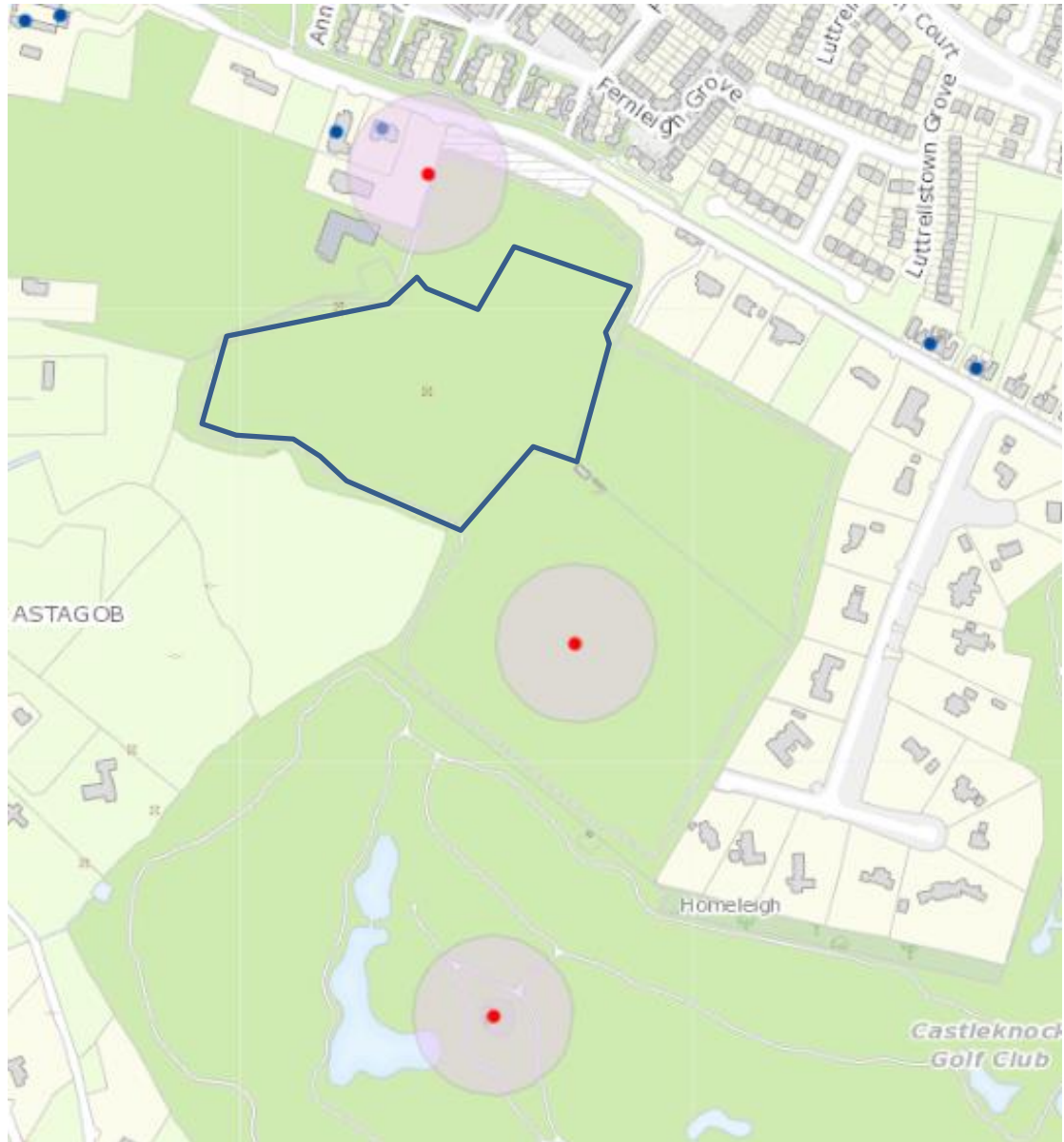

There are no Recorded Monuments within the area subject to the Part 8 application.

To the north is DU017-005, Porterstown Ringfort site. Geophysical survey (NMS Licence Ref: 06R180) shows that the sub-surface remains extend into Porterstown Park.

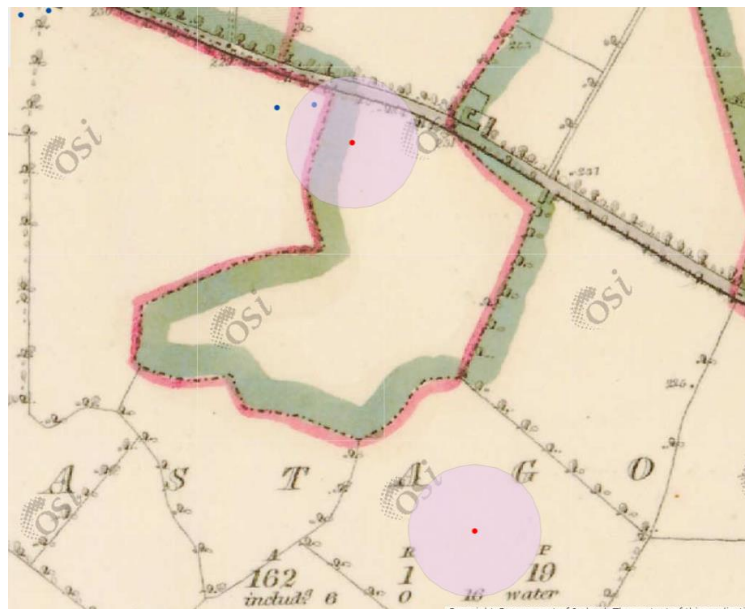

It is recommended that service installation e.g. lighting, electrics etc.) for the proposed development should avoid disturbing this area. If any works are to impact upon the Zone of Notification of the monument DU017-005, they must to be referred to the National Monuments Service, Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht, at least two months in advance for their requirements.

The proposed development is bounded by the historic townland boundary. However aerial photographs show the site to have been graded, landscaped, and playing pitches installed. The proposed development shows the area of most significant impact (see profile A-A1 #5595-02) to

coincide with a previously graded area. The potential impact on archaeological remains can therefore be considered low. Should archaeological material be uncovered during works it must be reported to the relevant authorities.
