**PROPOSED DRAFT FINGAL COUNTY
COUNCIL BURIAL GROUND
BYE-LAWS 2021**

Fingal County Council, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 199 of the Local Government Act 2001 (as amended) for the Regulation of Cemeteries hereby gives notice that it proposes to adopt Fingal County Council Burial Ground Bye-Laws 2021.

Copies of the Draft Bye-Laws shall be retained at **Fingal County Council offices at Grove Road, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15, and County Hall, Main Street, Swords, Co. Dublin, and the Fingal Libraries in Blanchardstown, Swords and Malahide** for inspection during normal office hours over the period **Wednesday 3rd August 2022 to Wednesday 14th September 2022 inclusive.**
