The proposed development consists of the alteration and renovation of two existing semi-detached 19th century dwellings and the construction of extensions to the side and the rear of the buildings to provide an additional 11 dwellings, bringing the total number of dwellings on the site to 13 dwellings, including 6 no. 1 bed dwellings and 7 no. 2 bed dwellings. The development proposes significant changes to a previously approved proposal F16A/0166, and includes the demolition of the existing range building, other outbuildings, dwelling extensions to the north and rear, the boundary walls to the north and east.

Other associated site works include the retention and renovation of the stone boundary walls facing North Street to the west and the southern wall of the range building with the school to the south, the construction of a shared surface entranceway with parking for 6 no. vehicles and landscaped communal areas with bin and bike storage provisions.
