



**ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS 1993 – 2015
PUBLIC TRANSPORT REGULATION ACT, 2009
TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEMES
CHAPEL ROAD, KINSEALY AND GLENCARRAIG,
SUTTON, CO. DUBLIN**

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared Schemes for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following locations:

- Chapel Road, Kinsealy, Co. Dubin – 5 No. Bus Friendly Traffic Calming Ramps
- Glencarraig, Sutton, Dublin 13 – 4 No. New Traffic Calming Ramps

The schemes provide for traffic calming ramps, appropriate road signage and markings where necessary.

Plans and particulars of the Schemes as shown on Drawing Numbers: 2023-PD-TC-001 and 2023-PD-TC-002, are available for inspection from Wednesday 28th June to Thursday 27th July 2023.
