

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared Schemes for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following locations:

- Alden Road, Bayside - Removal of 3 sets of Traffic Calming Cushions and Install 6 No. Round Top Traffic Calming Ramps.
- R124 at Galtrim Grange - 1 No. set Traffic Calming Cushions. & 2 No. Round Top Bus Friendly Ramps.
- Drumnigh Road, Portmarnock - 2 No. sets Traffic Calming Cushions & 2 No. Round Top Bus Friendly Ramps.
- Grove Road, Malahide - 5 no. Round Top Traffic Calming Ramps.
- Yellow Walls Road at Milford, Malahide - 1 No. Raised Uncontrolled Crossing.

The schemes provide for traffic calming ramps, appropriate road signage and markings where necessary.

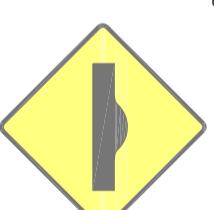

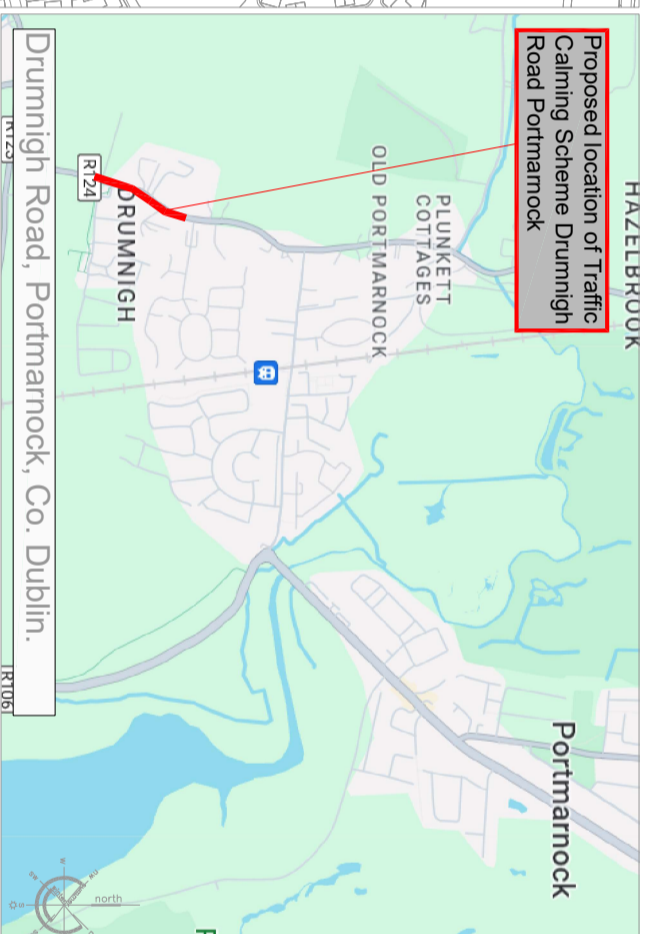

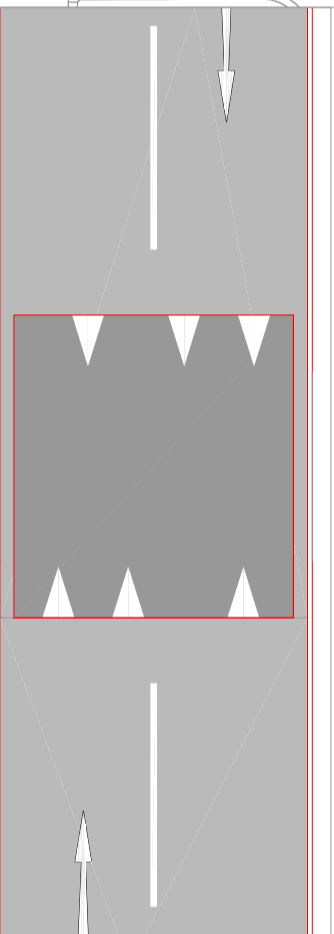

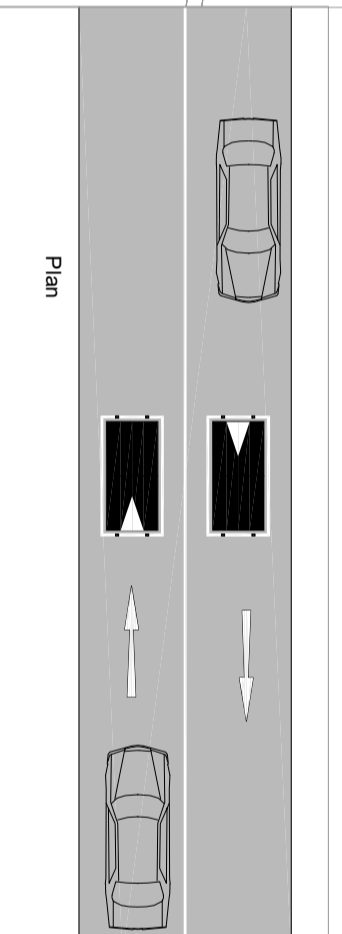

Bus Friendly Round Top Traffic Calming Ramp

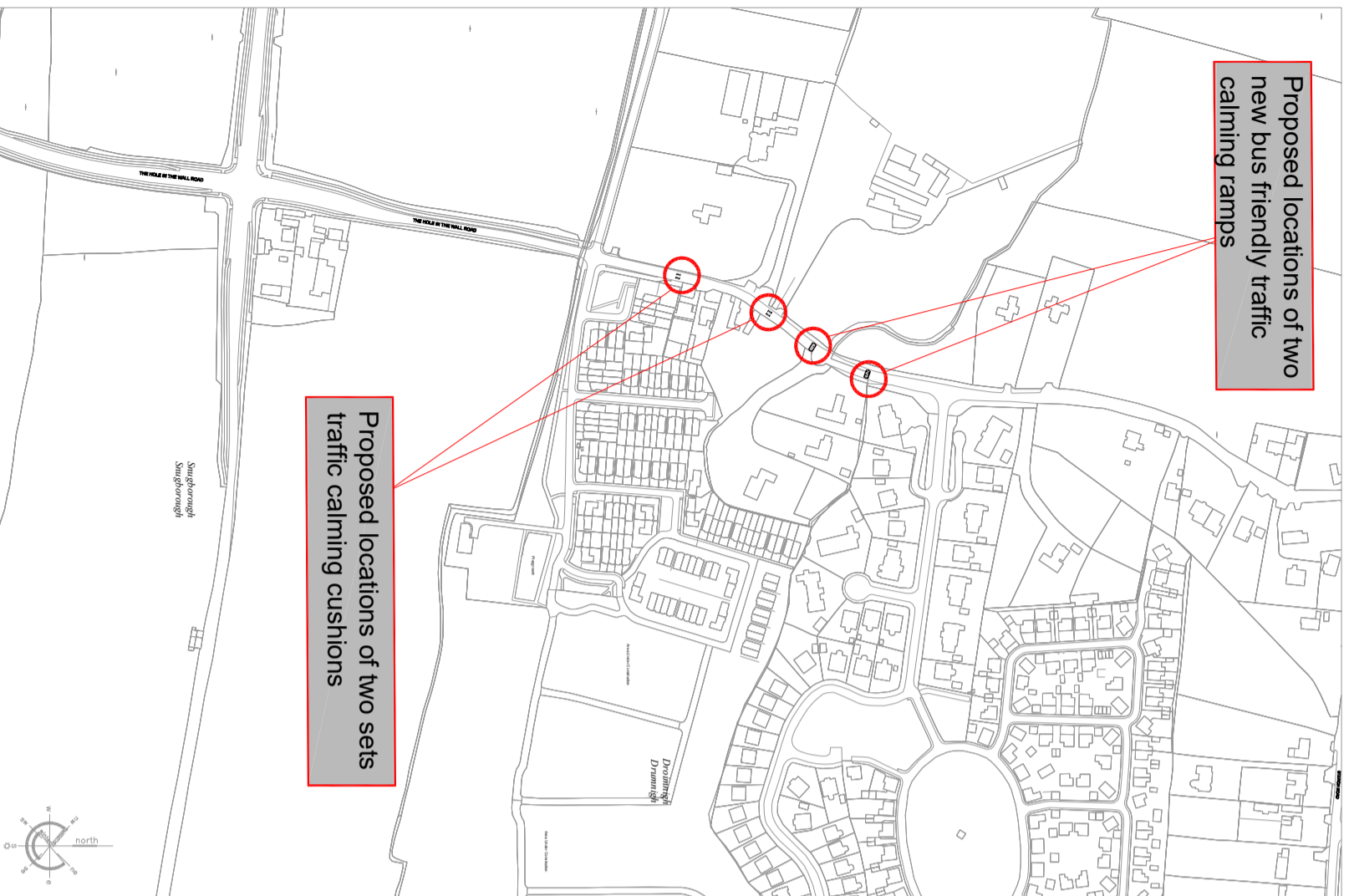
