




PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

Proposed Amendments to Existing Protected Structures

Within the current Record of Protected Structures (RPS) there are a number of individual RPS entries that relate to complexes containing multiple buildings. This is indicated in the description in the RPS. It has been decided to amend the RPS in relation to four properties to create distinct entries for the different buildings to provide clarity on what the designation covers where the structures are in separate ownership or where they are from different eras or where the locations of the buildings are spread across a large site.

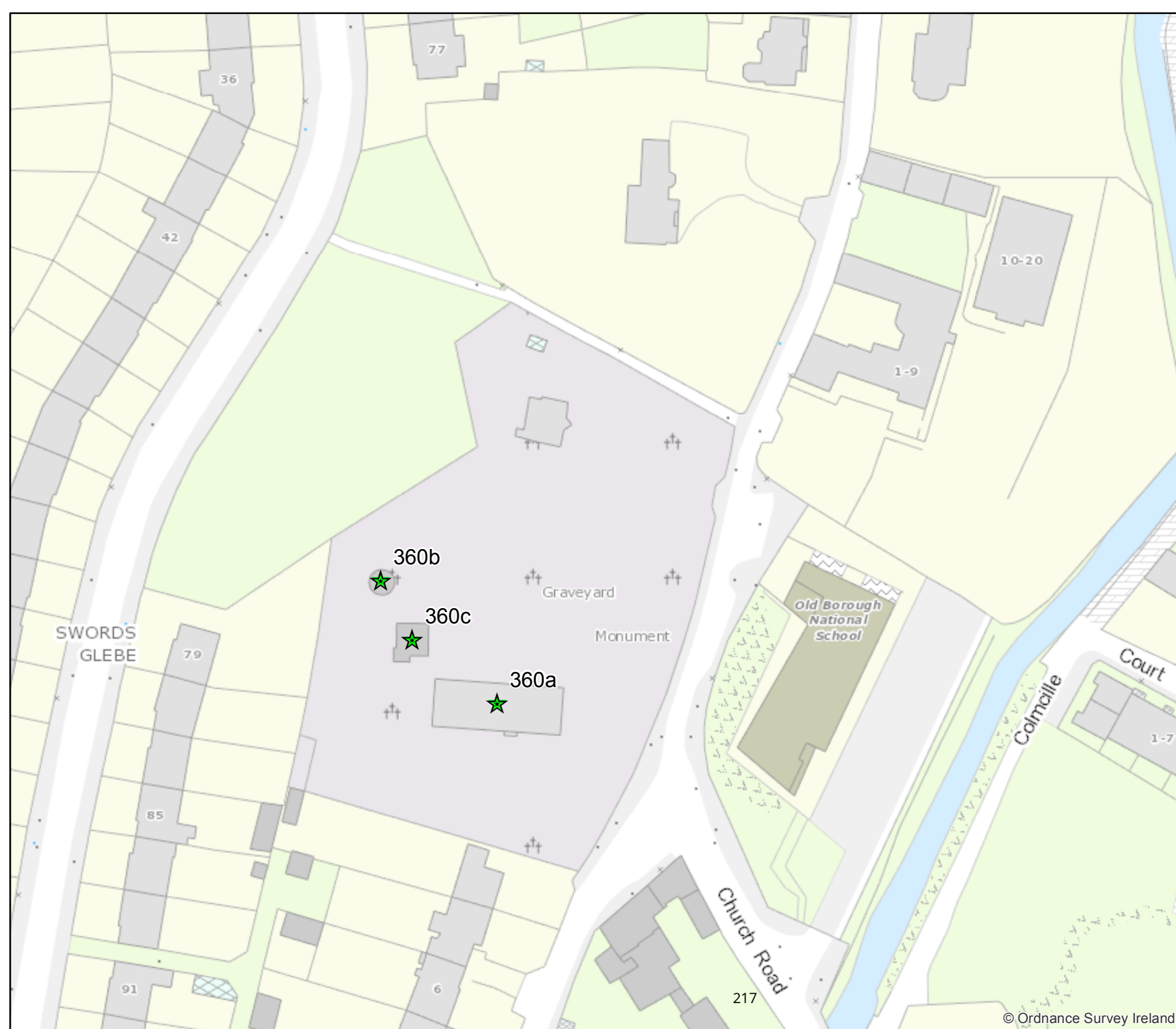

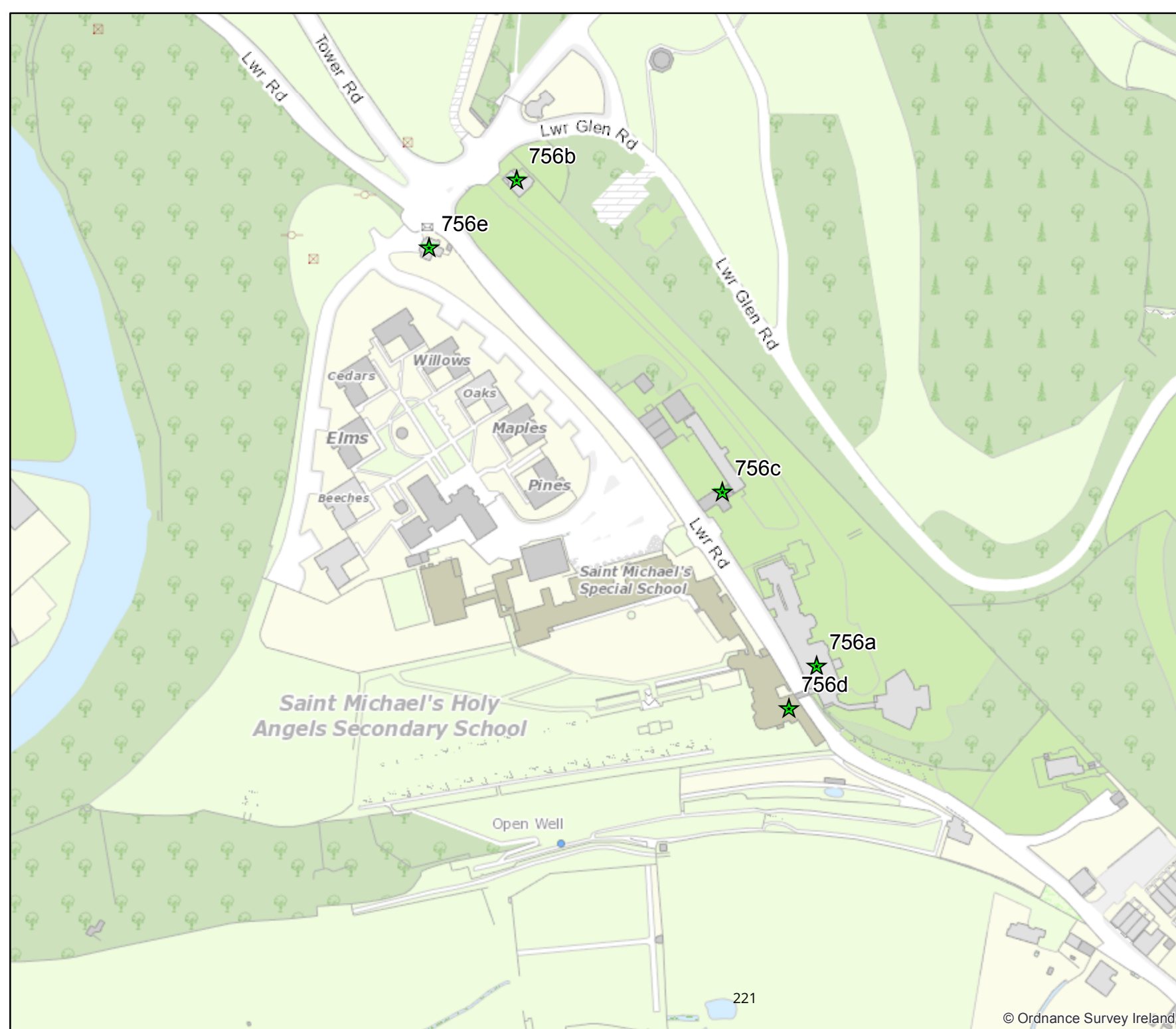

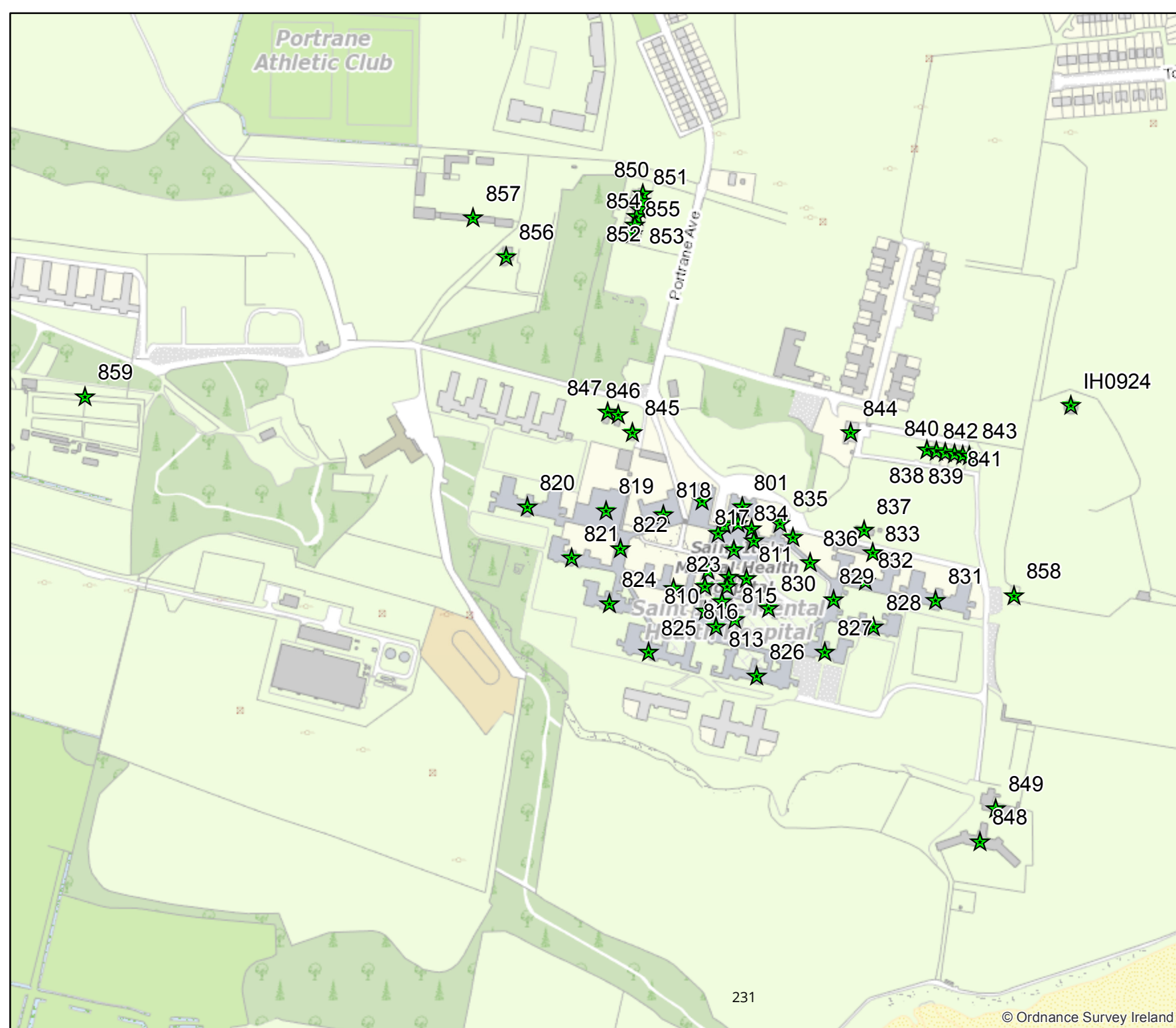
