PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 – 2015**

**Proposed construction of Kellystown Cemetery and Access Road (off Diswellstown Road) on lands in Kellystown, north of Luttrellstown Castle Golf & Country Club, Dublin 15.**

In accordance with Part XI of the Local Government Planning and Development Act 2000 to 2015 and Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 - 2015, Fingal County Council hereby gives notice of the **proposed works** to be carried out at the above site:

*Fingal County Council (Operations Department) is proposing to develop a new Kellystown Cemetery to provide approximately 3000 burial plots, 500 memorial plots and 500 niches in columbarium walls on lands ( 3.706 Ha) north of Porterstown Road.*

*The proposals also include the construction of a new carpark, a service building and all associated site development works including footpaths, concrete plinths, bin shelters, site landscaping, fencing and boundary walls.*

*A westward extension of Diswellstown Road from the existing schools entrance including a new access road to the cemetery will be developed on adjoining lands (approx. 04Ha).*
