**Applicant:** Fingal County Council    **Location:** The Glebe Park, Balrothery, Co. Dublin

**Proposal:** Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given of a Proposed Strategic Plan for The Glebe Park, Balrothery.

Proposed improvements to the park will comprise of the following:

- New Play Facilities including Children's Playground and Multi-use Games Area.
- New Adult Exercise Facilities.
- Improved Path Network including resurfacing of existing paths, additional sections of footpaths and improved vehicular/pedestrian access.
- Upgrading of Car Parking.
- Improvements to Sports facilities (Upgrading of existing sports pitch, development of a new sports pitch and tennis court).
- Provision of a Community Garden Area.
- Provision of additional seating and structure tree planting/Arboretum.
- Provision of additional information/interpretative signage.
