**Proposed development of a Central Staff
Facility at Fingal County Council Works
Depot, Porters Road, Coolmine, Dublin 15**

In accordance with Part XI of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), Fingal County Council hereby gives notice of the **proposed works** to be carried out at the above site:

the demolition of existing building and the erection of two pre-fabricated extensions (Total floor area 486M²) either side of existing pre-fabricated staff canteen building, comprising outdoor staff changing rooms & toilets extension (297M²) and an office extension (189M²); plus associated ground works and service connections
