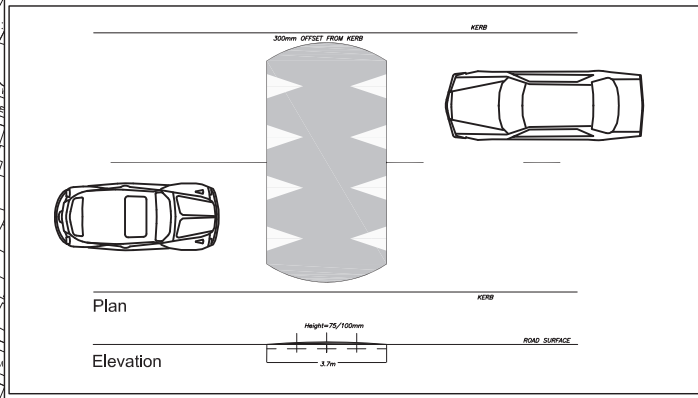

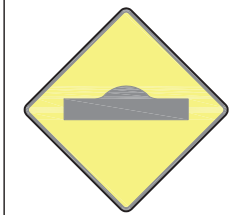


Seabury Road, Malahide, Co. Dublin.

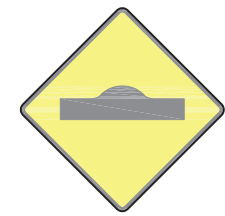

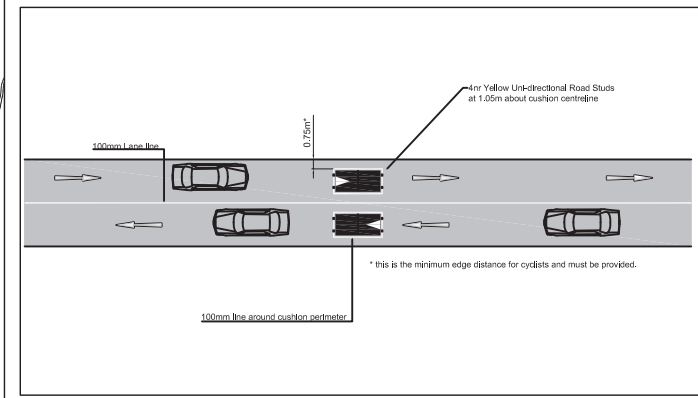




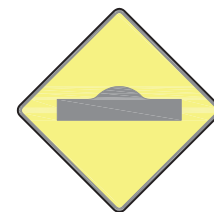
