Caibidil: Section 1: Written Statement » Chapter 6: Connectivity and Movement

Preserve the tree lined approach on the Whitestown Road Rush beginning at the area at Old Road / Whitestown Road in the direction of Rush Mainstreet.

Údar: Cllr Brian Dennehy

Facilitate provision of a complete pedestrian linkage on the western side of the Park Road, Rush from the Brook Lane / Park Road junction to St. Maurs GAA Club entrance.

Upgrade Brook Lane, Rush to Distributor Road standard whilst ensuring the rural and amenity character is protected.

Carry out an assessment of traffic needs to inform the feasibility of providing a Distributor Road to the west of Rush.

Promote and facilitate the linkage by means of public pathway the Martello Tower on the Drumanagh Promontory Fort site, Rush to a public walkway around the perimeter of the Drumanagh Promontory Fort, Rush

Implement in full the measures outlined in 'The Landfill Restoration Plans' in the Rogerstown Estuary Study and provide for a landscaped public amenity space incorporating woodland and screen planting, pathways and seating areas, carparking, visitors centre and a boardwalk southwards alongside the railway line to Donabate.

That this Council resolves that "all roads in residential area's of Fingal included to be resurfaced in the annual works programmes should be resurfaced with tarmacadam producing reduced noise levels from passing traffic."

Community infastructure

Caibidil: Section 1: Written Statement » Chapter 4: Community Infrastructure and Open Space

The future burial requirements of the county including Columbarium walls will be accommodated within the all the graveyards where possible.

Provide and facilitate the development of additional burial grounds, extend existing burial grounds where possible, including green graveyards / natural burial grounds in areas across Fingal as required during the life of the Development Plan and which preferably have good public transport links, taking cognisance of the needs of multifaith and non-religious communities.

Areas of open space of less than 250 square metres will not be taken in charge by Fingal County Council for maintenance purposes.

Give careful consideration to the appropriateness and location of fast food outlets in the vicinity of schools and, where considered appropriate, to restrict the opening of new fast food/takeaway outlets to an effective no-fry zone that will be set at 1km in proximity to schools so as to protect the health and wellbeing of school-going children.

This Council resolves to "Ensure all new developments of 250 units or more make on site provision for provide bank facilities for bottle recycling."
