**Addendum Notice** concerning an application for approval made by Fingal County Council to An Bord Pleanála under sections 175(3), 177AE, 226 and 177S(2)(h) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) to carry out a proposed development consisting of a new greenway (shared footpath and cyclepath) approximately 6km in length, between Malahide Demesne and Newbridge Demesne, in the townlands of Malahide Demesne, Malahide, Kilcrea, Newbridge Demesne and Donabate, Fingal, County Dublin, to be known as the Broadmeadow Way.

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and a Natura Impact Assessment (NIS) have been prepared in respect of the proposed development and accompany the application.

An Bord Pleanála may give approval to the application for development with or without conditions or may refuse the application for development.

Please note that submissions and observations may be made in writing to An Bord Pleanála relating to the implications of the proposed development (An Bord Pleanála Reference: PL06F.304624) for proper planning and sustainable development in the area, the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, and the likely significant effects of the proposed development in the area concerned on European Sites, if carried out.

**Please note that any submissions and observations made in writing to An Bord Pleanála must be accompanied by a prescribed fee of €50 (Fifty Euro). Submissions and observations not accompanied by the required prescribed fee of €50 (Fifty Euro) shall be invalid.**

Submissions and observations should be received by An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, not later than **5.30pm on the 5th September 2019**.

A person may question the validity of any decision by An Bord Pleanála on the approval application by way of an application for judicial review under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986) and in accordance with Section 50 of the Planning and Development Acts, 2000 (as amended).
