## ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS 1993 – 2015 PUBLIC TRANSPORT REGULATION ACT, 2009 TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEMES BALBRIGGAN/ SWORDS

Fingal County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared Schemes for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following locations:

St Cronan's Avenue, Swords, Co. Dublin 2 No. Set of Ramps

The schemes include the provision of traffic calming ramps, appropriate road signage and markings where necessary.


