



N3 M50 TO CLONEE NON - STATUTORY PUBLIC CONSULTATION EMERGING PREFERRED OPTION

Fingal County Council, in conjunction with Meath County Council and in collaboration with Transport Infrastructure Ireland is in the process of developing scheme options for the improvement of the N3 national primary route between the N3/M50 Interchange at Blanchardstown, Dublin 15 and the N3-M3 at Clonee West Interchange, Co. Meath.

Currently the scheme is at the route option selection stage. A number of potential options have been considered and the consultation will provide an overview of the scheme and the project team is now inviting anyone with an interest in the scheme to give us their comments and feedback on the Emerging Preferred Option.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic and public health restrictions on gatherings, a traditional, in-person public consultation event is unfortunately not possible during this round of public consultation. However, your feedback on the scheme is still very important to us and we would encourage you to take part in the process.
