



PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL SPEED LIMITS) (COUNTY OF FINGAL) BYE-LAWS 2020

In accordance with Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act 2004, for the purpose of installing new Bus Friendly Traffic Calming Ramps on Chapel Road Kinsealy, as part of the proposed traffic calming schemes currently on public display, and in the interest of road safety, the Proposed Amendments to the 'Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) County of Fingal Bye-Laws 2020' have been prepared as following:

Road enclosed by a line commencing at a point on Chapel Road Eastbound 575 meters to point 250 meters on Chapel Road Eastbound to entrance at Kinsealy Hall. (250 meters 60k/h amended to 50k/h) – Drawing Number: 2023-PD-SSL-001.
