Description

A holy well that is a natural spring covered with corrugated iron and overgrown.

Appraisal

A holy well that formerly had a pattern day but is no longer venerated. The holy well is thought to have the cure for sore eyes. There are not sufficient structural remains of architectural interest present to warrant its retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the holy well exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004 as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU001-001.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that St Brigid's Well, Tobersool Lane, Tobersool, Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures

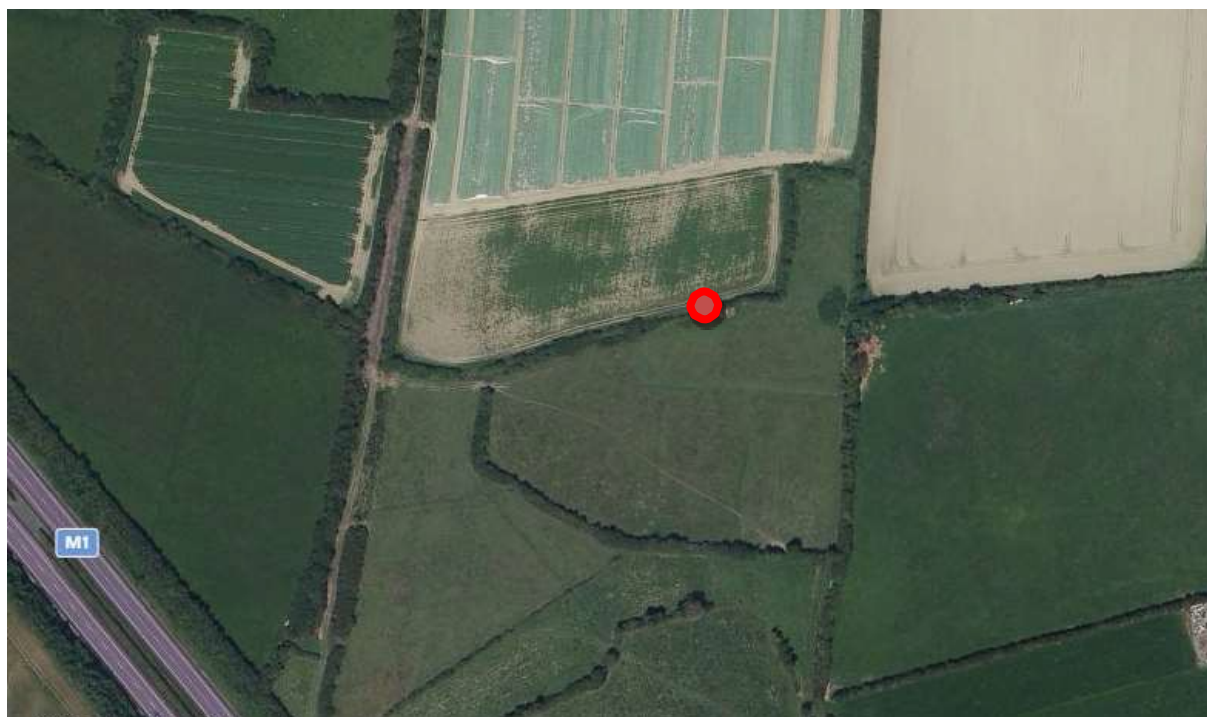

Appraisal

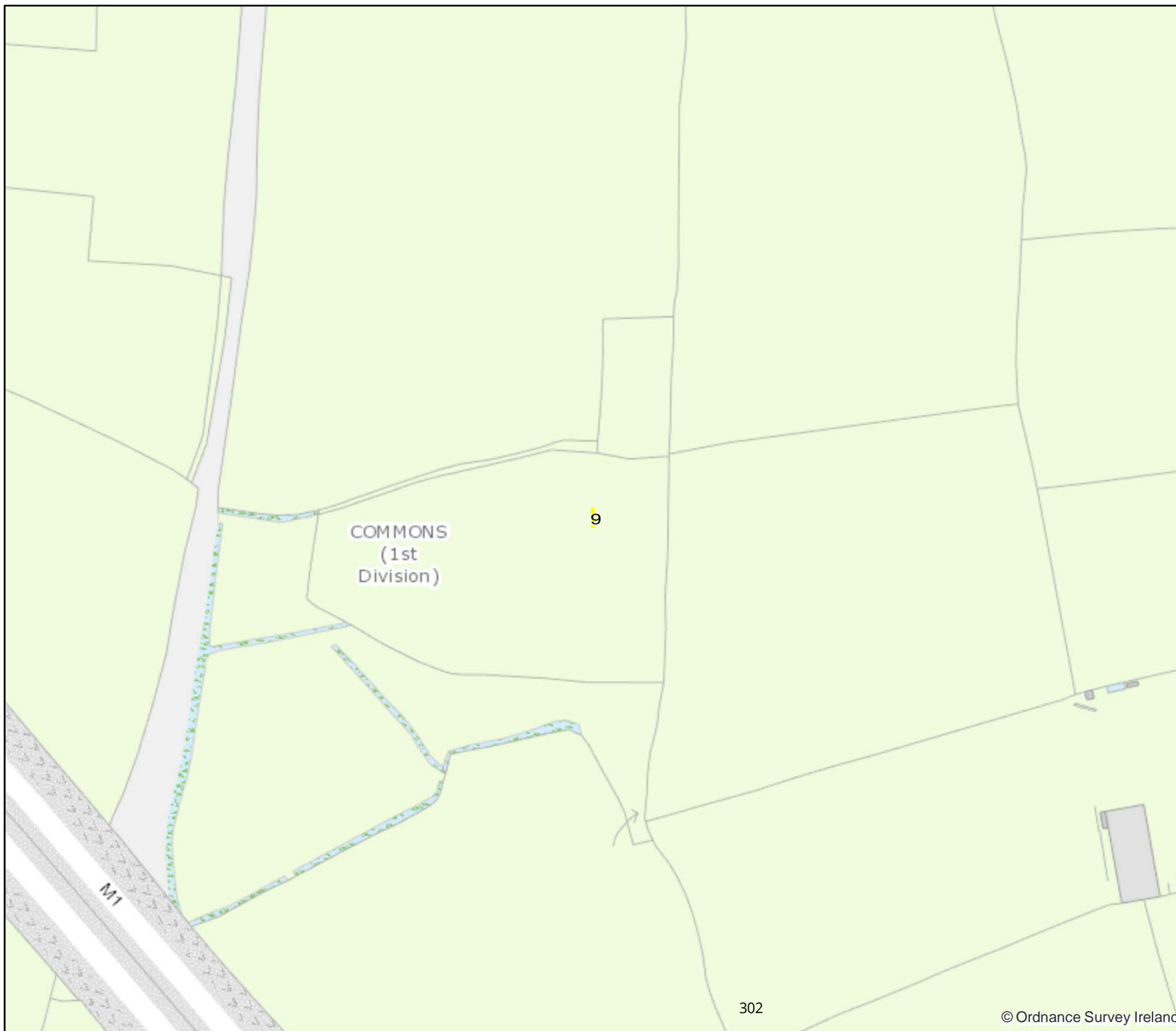

Description

Crop mark of a roughly circular enclosure (c.50m diam.) with a levelled field bank radiating from the north.

Appraisal

The enclosure was identified on a 1971 aerial photograph (CUCAP, BGL 6) as a crop mark but was not visible at ground level. There are no surface remains present to warrant its retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the enclosure site exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU004-003

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Potential Site, Balscadden, Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures

Description

Roughly circular natural spring well, within an area of natural rock outcrop.

Appraisal

Circular water filled depression into which modern drains empty. Used as a dumping ground in recent years. There are not sufficient structural remains of architectural interest present to warrant its retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the holy well exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU001-004.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Lady Well, Flemingtown Lane, Flemingtown, Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures
