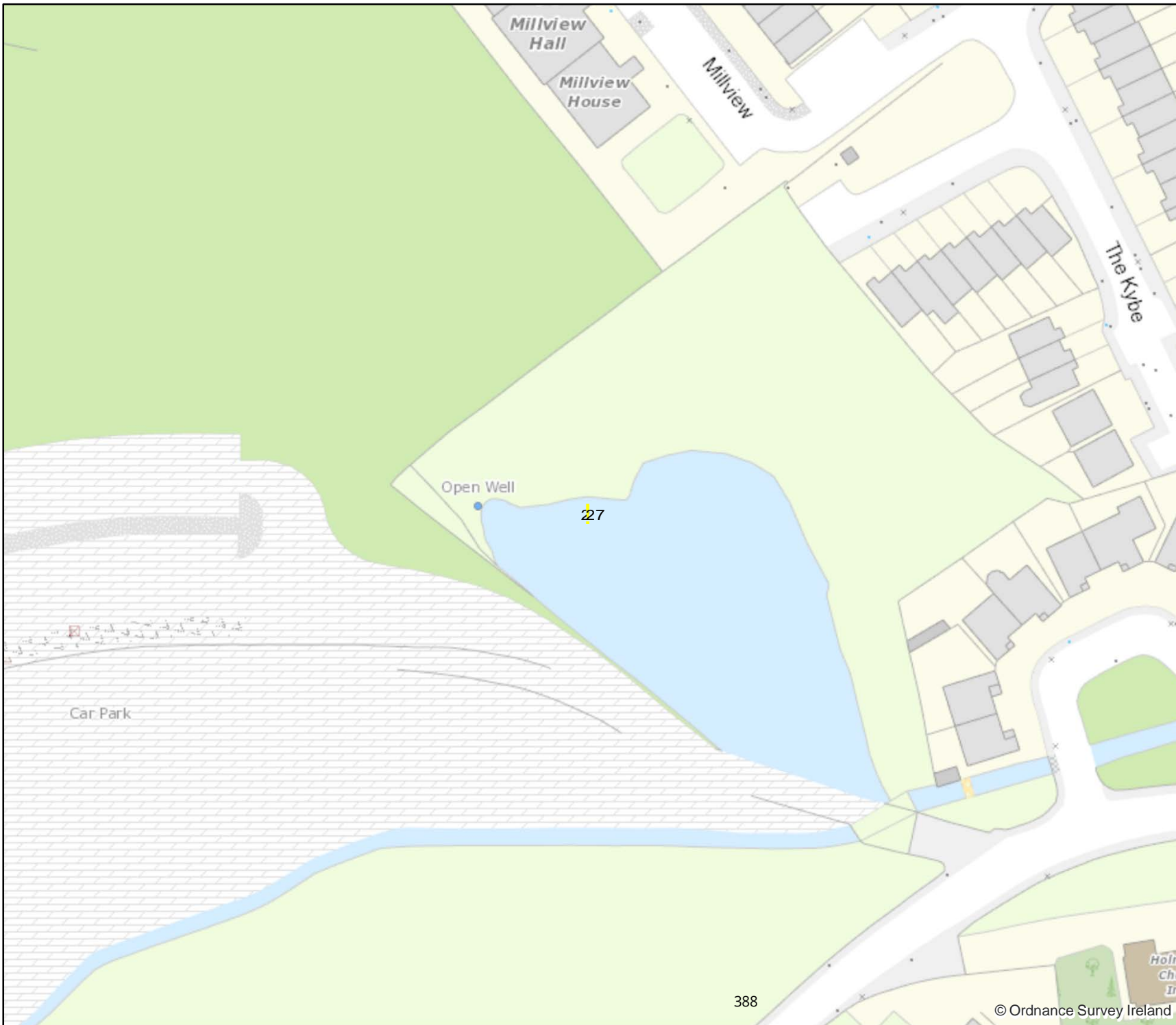
Description

Former enclosed well located in north-west corner of pond at entrance to Skerries mill complex.

Appraisal

The enclosed spring well is now underwater within Skerries Mill Pond. There are insufficient structural remains present to warrant retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the well site exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU005-030.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Kibe Well, Mill Hill, Townparks (Skerries), Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures.

Description

This site has been incorporated into Milverton Quay since 1970 i.e. Cists.

Appraisal

There is a tradition of burials 'in stone coffins' being discovered at Milverton. Traditionally known as the Danes burial ground, the site is classified as a cist site on the Record of Protected Structures. There are no structural remains visible above ground to warrant retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the cist site exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004 as a Recorded Monument RMP Ref DU005-032.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Burials (Site of), Milverton, Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures.

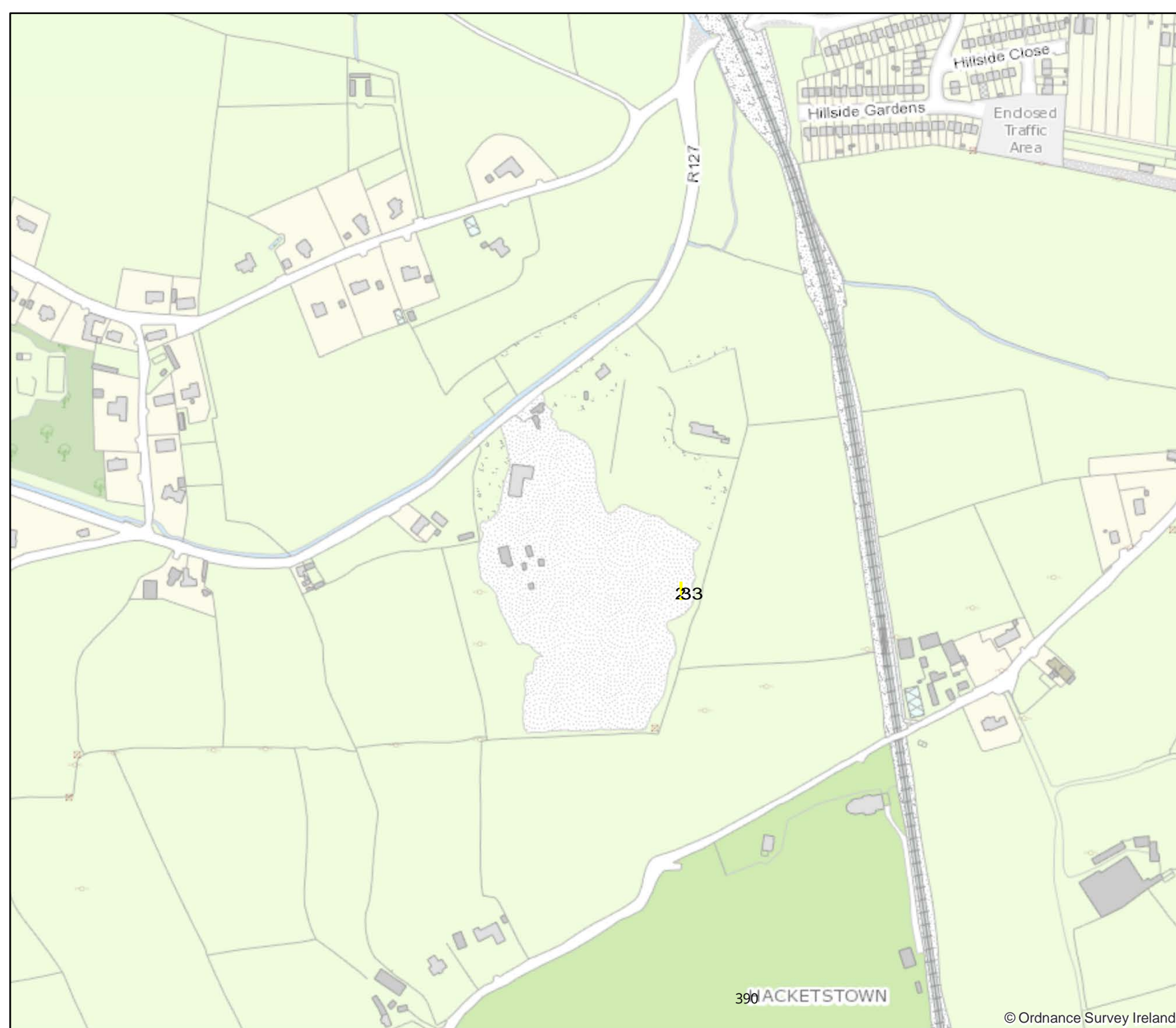

Description

Enclosed spring well with drystone passage, located adjoining a stream in the grounds of a farmhouse.

Appraisal

The site is completely overgrown. There are limited structural remains present to warrant retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the well exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU005-036.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Lady Well, Baldongan Road, Balcunnin, Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures.
