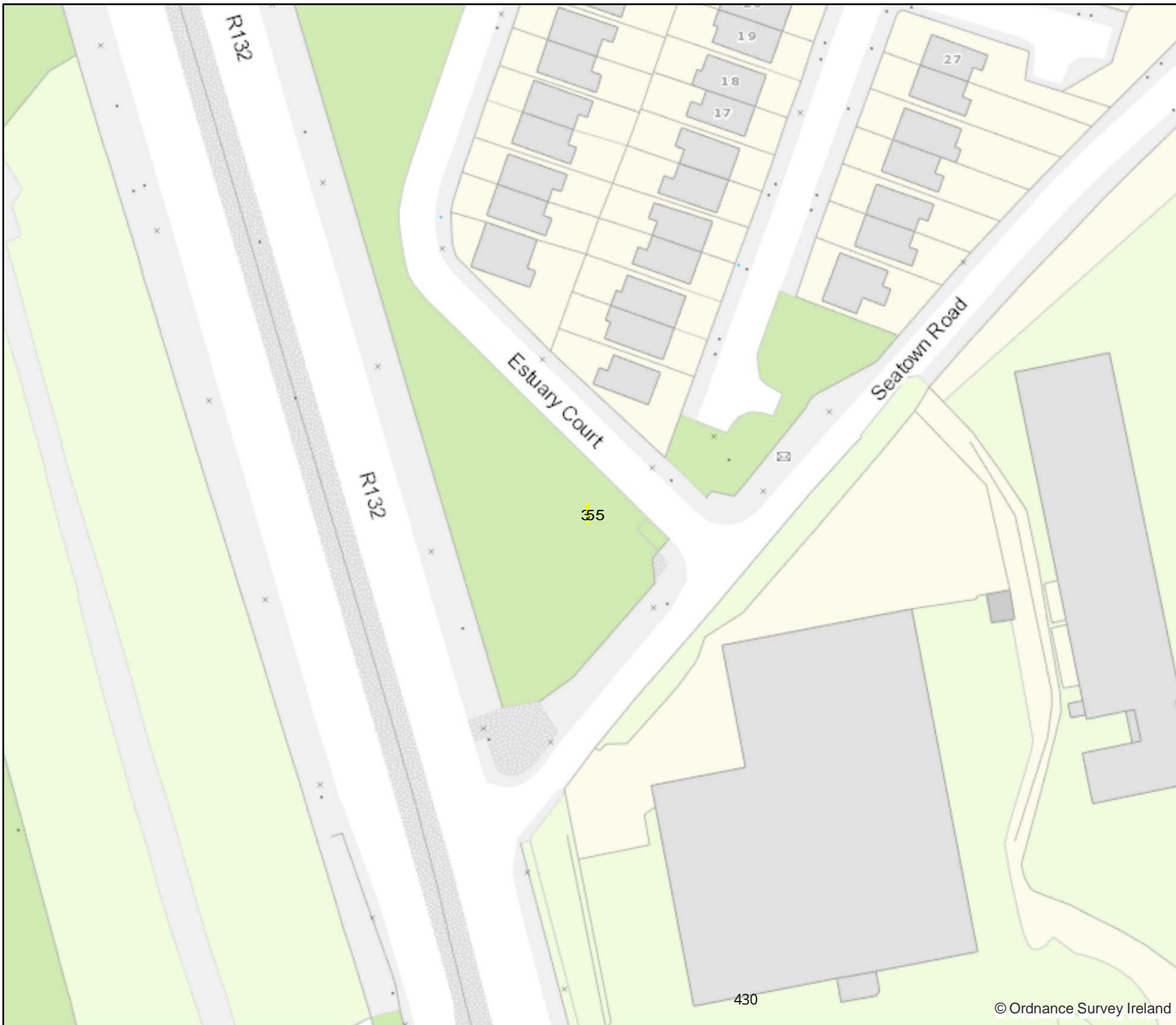
**Description**

**Appraisal**

Site shown on Duncan’s 1821 map. Now under Estuary Court housing estate. There are no structural remains present above ground to warrant retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the earthwork site exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU011-036.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that Earthwork Unclassified, Seatown Road, Seatown West (Swords), Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures.

**Appraisal**

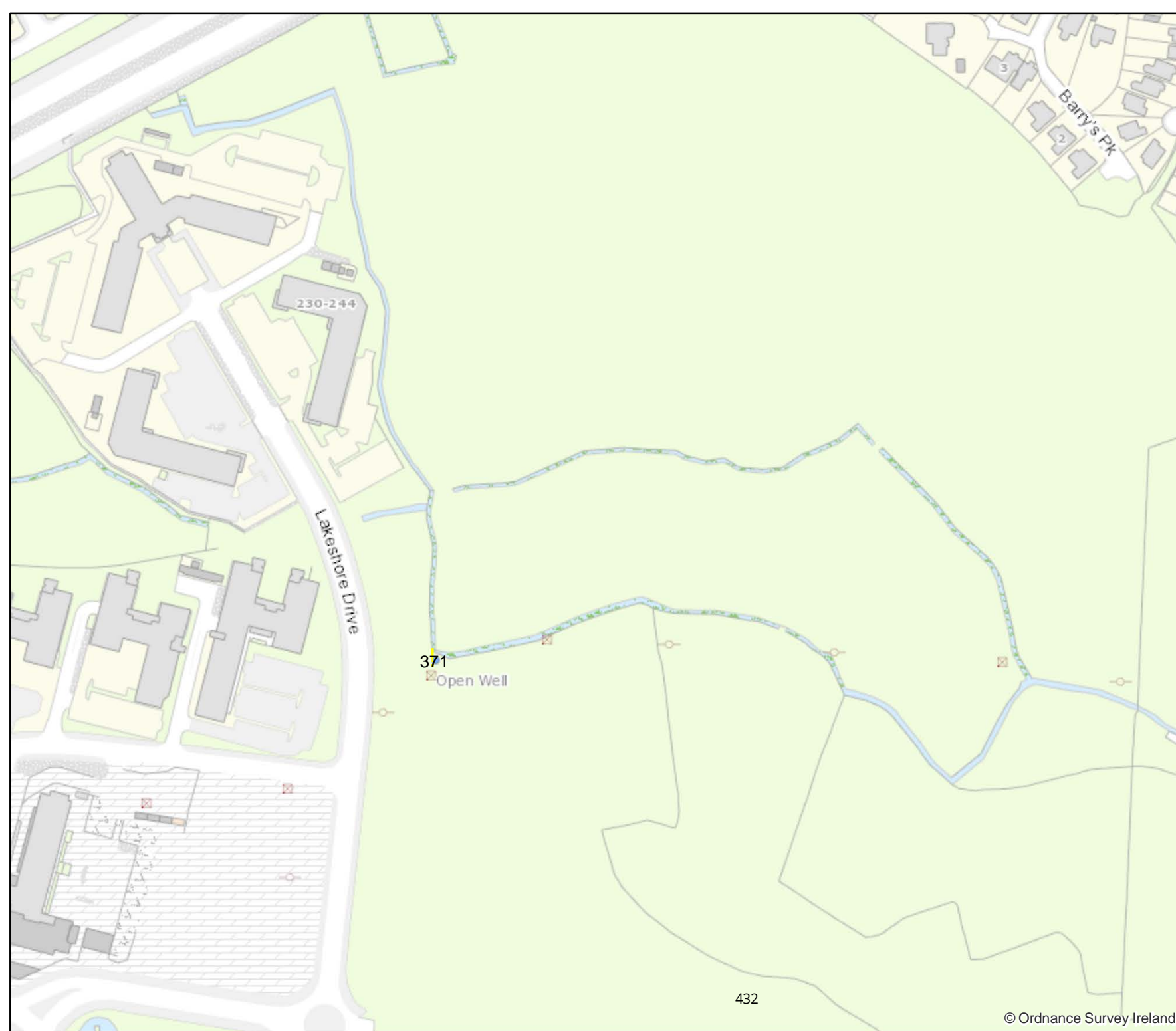
The well site had become overgrown but was re-dug by enthusiasts in 2011 in a different position. There are no original structural remains present to warrant retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for St Werburgh's well exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU011-045.

**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that St. Werburgh's Well, Airside Business Park, Lakeshore Drive, Crowcastle (Swords), Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures.

There are no structural remains present to warrant retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the cemetery exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU011-032.

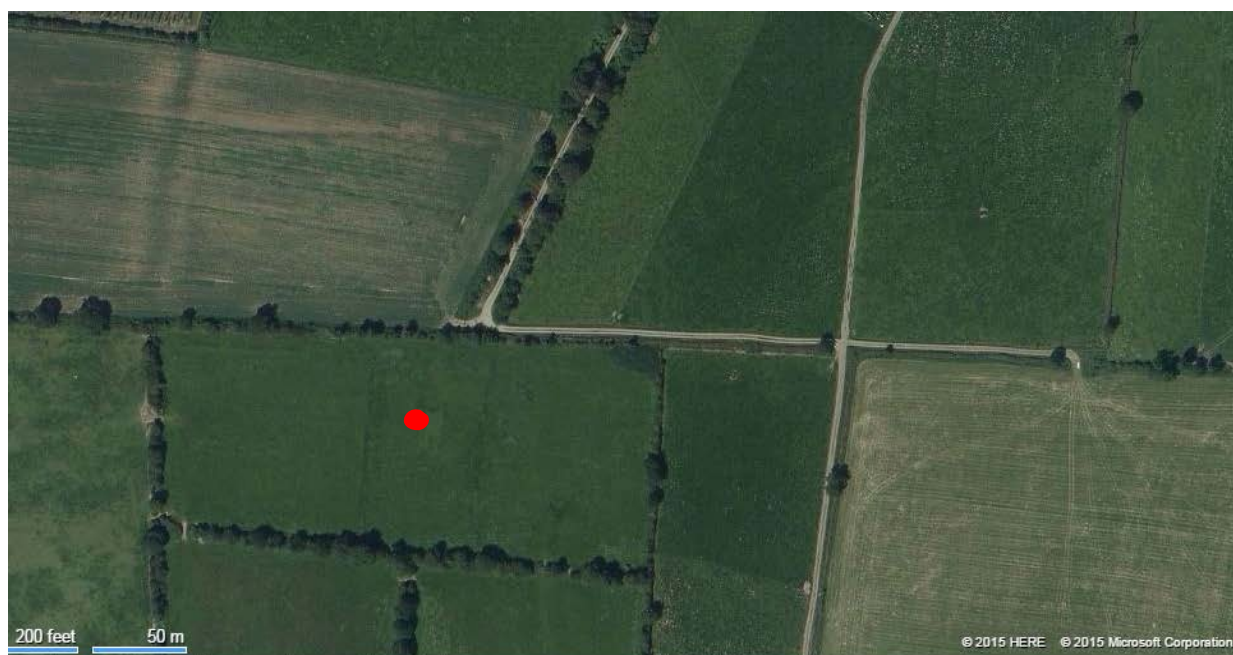

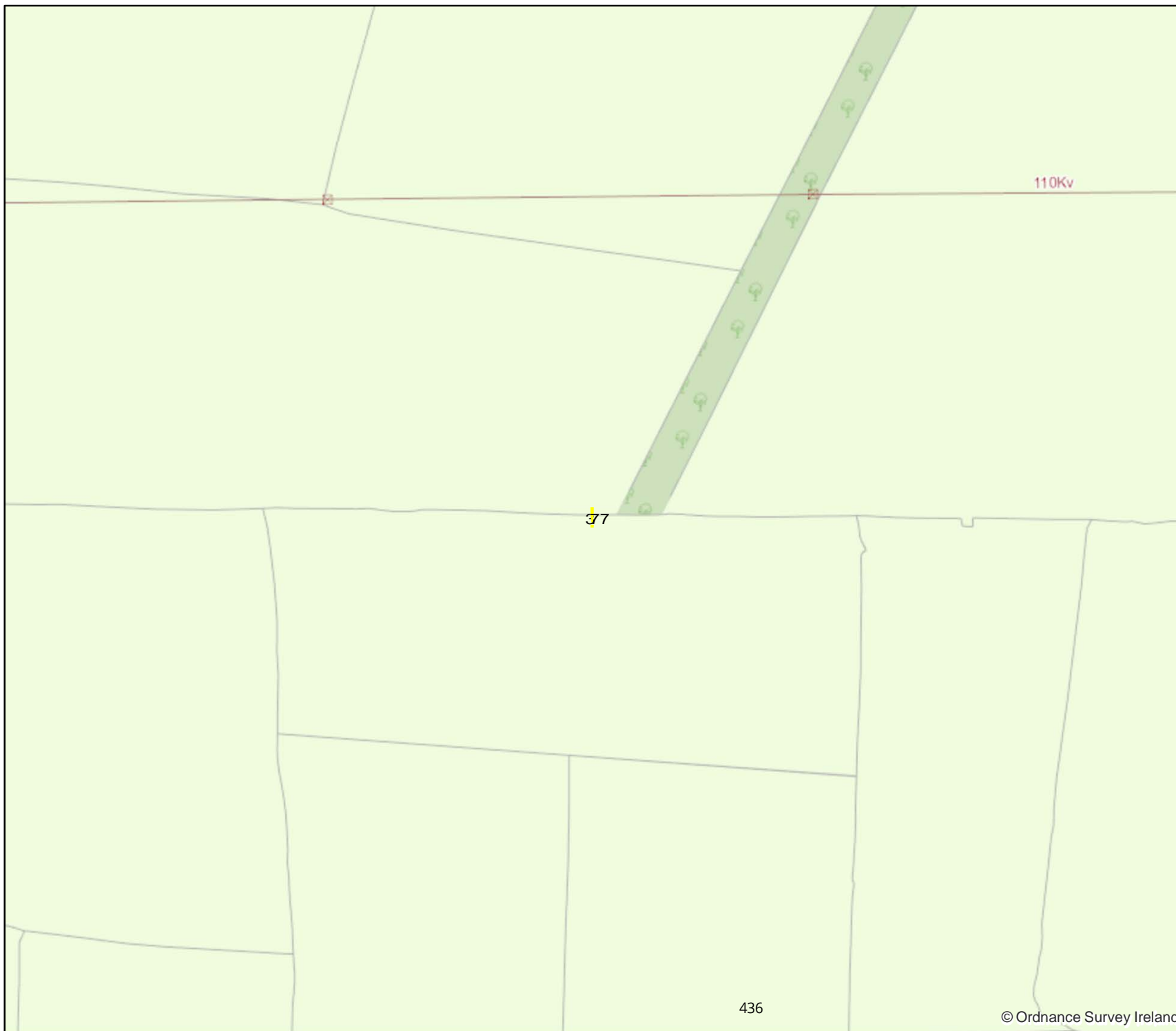

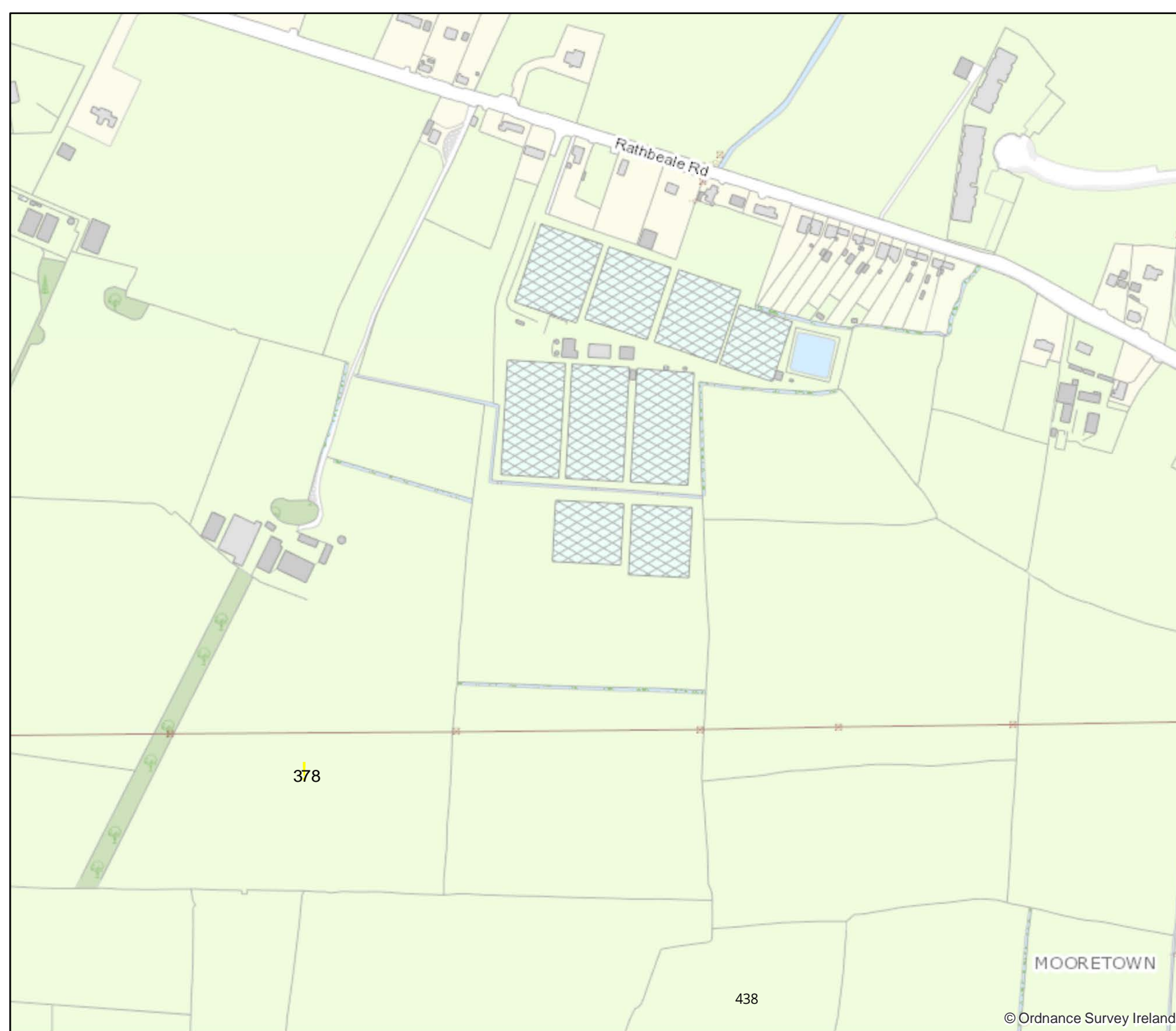
