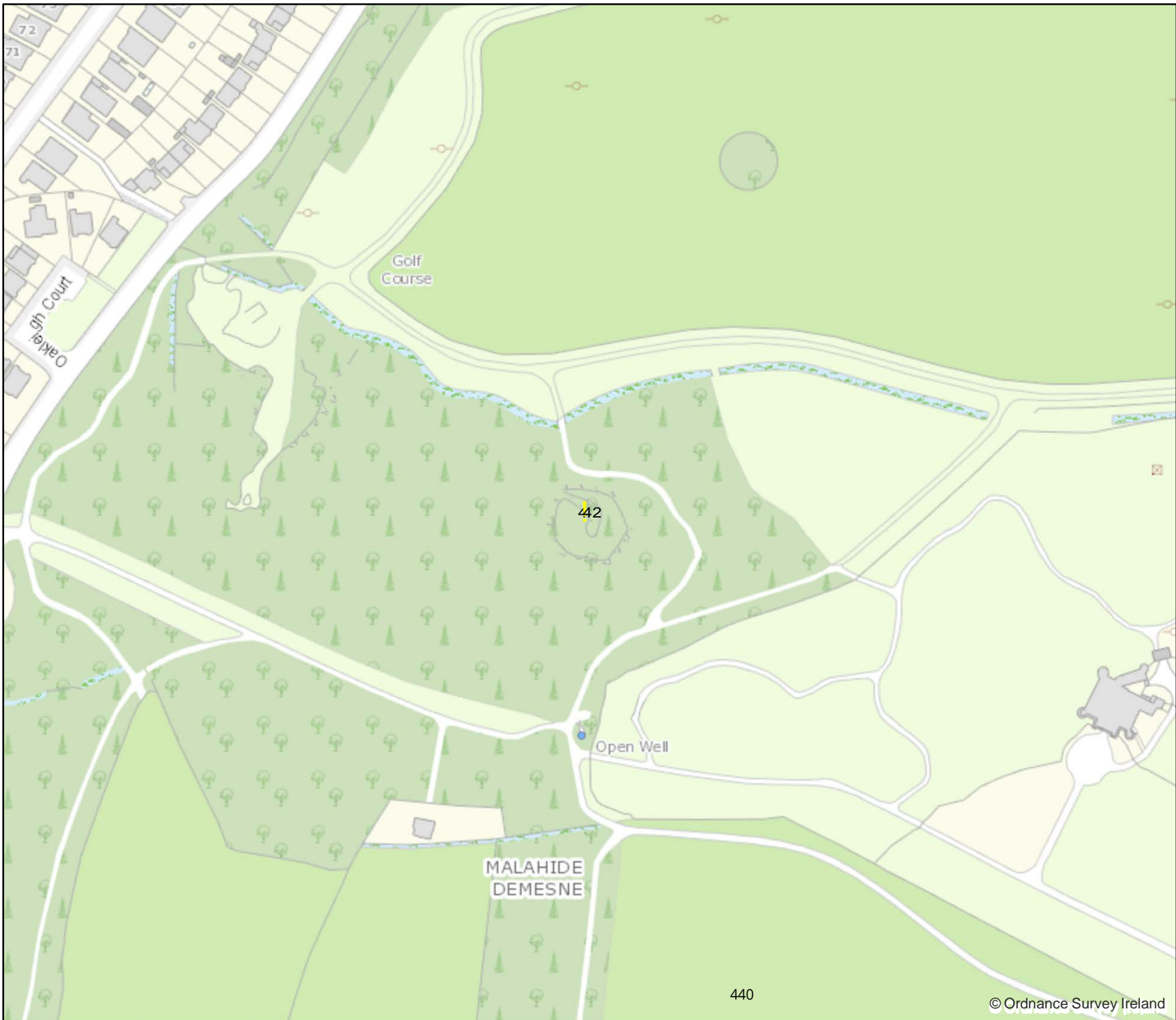
Description

Site of earthen platform within grounds of Malahide Castle Demesne.

Appraisal

The original earthen platform was circa 17m in diameter enclosed by an outer fosse and bank, but a record from 1915 indicates it was being quarried for gravel. There are insufficient structural remains present to warrant retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the earthwork site exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU012-029.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Earthwork 'site of', Malahide Demesne, Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures.

Description

Neolithic settlement site in field north of Limetree Ave and Elnor Court housing developments, Portmarnock.

Appraisal

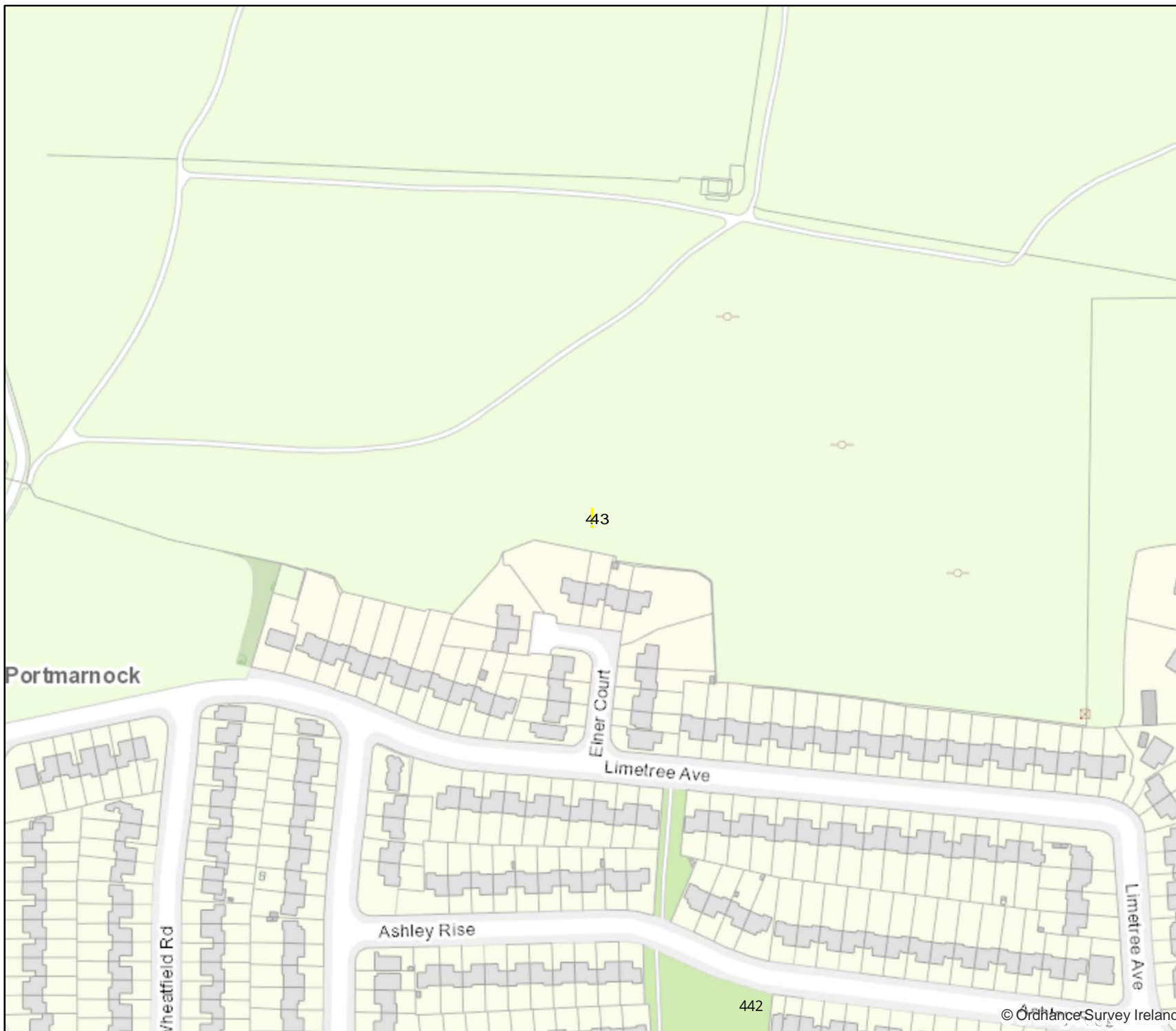
The Neolithic and Early Bronze Age site was indicated by flint artefacts recovered in 1980s. There are no structural remains present to warrant retention in the Record of Protected Structures. Alternative protection for the settlement site exists under the National Monuments Acts 1930-2004, as a Record Monument RMP Ref No. DU012-037.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that Settlement, Elnor Court, Robswalls (Portmarnock), Co. Dublin is deleted from the Record of Protected Structures.

Appraisal

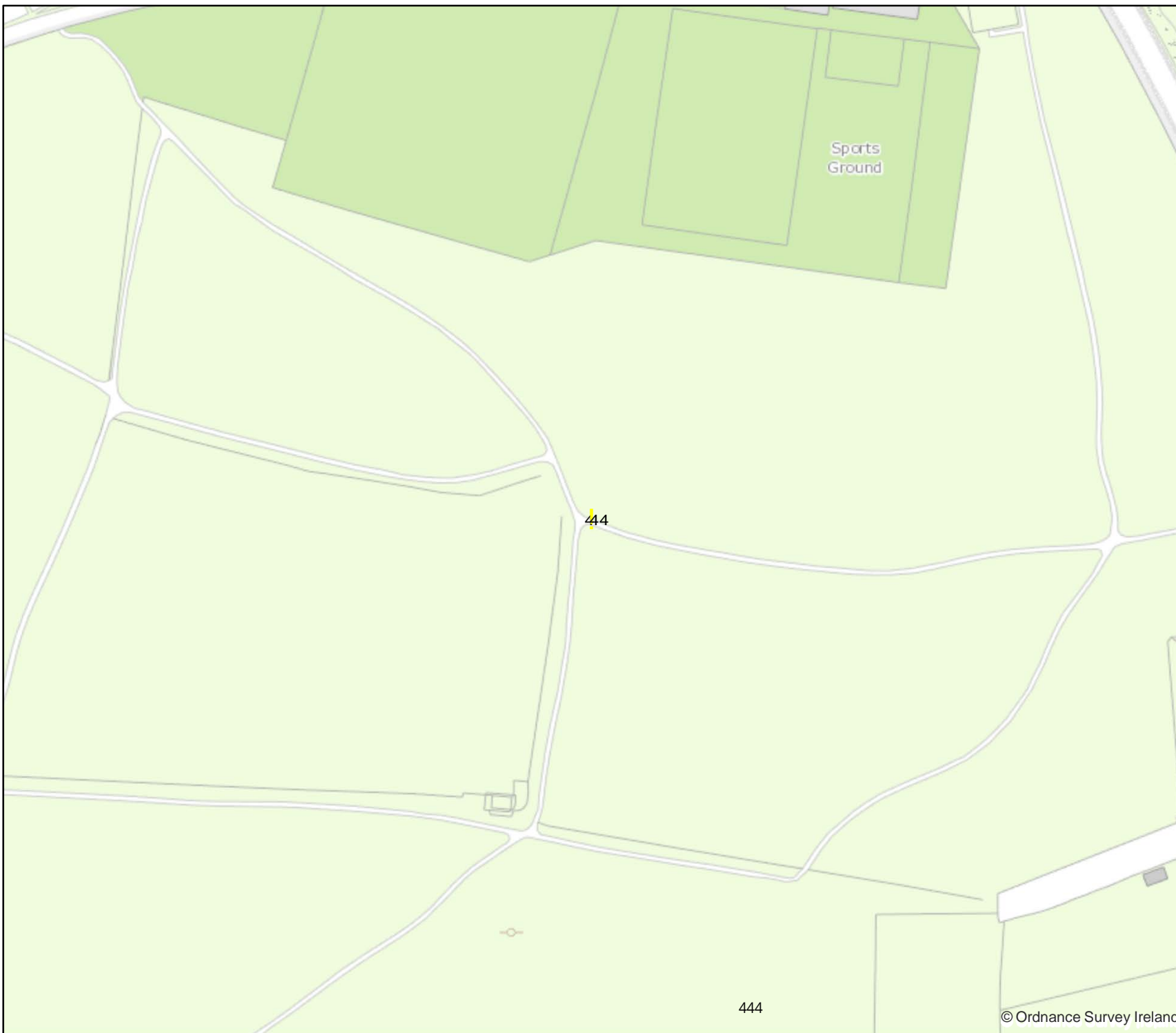
