No further yellow box junction markings are deemed required and the traffic signal sequence at the Rathbeale Road Junction is being amended to accommodate the diversion. Use by pedestrians of signalised crossing facilities should provide sufficient opportunity for access and egress from estates along the route at school times.
	Temporary car park not adequate	55 spaces will be provided in the temporary car park. It would be anticipated that parents of children from infant classes would use the temporary car park. Parents of older children would be encouraged to use the available set down area within the school grounds to drop off/pick up children. Parents would also be encouraged to walk/cycle with children to school.
	Additional works on Rathbeale Road and Balcultry Road	The Rathbeale Road Upgrade project is a LIHAF strategic infrastructure project majority funded by the Dept of HPLG, the project scope extends between the Rathbeale Cottages and Murrough Road junction.
FIN-C229-2	Provision of yellow box markings at junctions along the diversion route	Yellow box junction markings are being provided at the accesses to Sandford/Glen Ellan and Laurelton as there is deemed to be a future requirement due to queuing. No further yellow box junction markings are deemed required and the traffic signal sequence at the Rathbeale Road Junction is being amended to accommodate the diversion. Use by pedestrians of signalised crossing facilities should provide sufficient opportunity for access and egress from estates along the route at school times.

FIN-C229-4	Brides Glen access proximity to Glen Ellan Roundabout and additional traffic management measures. Extra Lights	The existing safe stopping distance from the Glen Ellan roundabout to the Brides Glen access are as per design requirements. 2 additional pedestrian crossings are being provided along the Castleview Extension and ramps are being provided at the school and community centre. The traffic signal sequence at the Rathbeale Road/Glen Ellan junction in being amended to accommodate the diversion. Yellow box junction markings are being provided at the accesses to Sandford/Glen Ellan and Laurelton as there is deemed to be a future requirement due to queuing. A signalised pedestrian crossing will be provided at the school. An additional pedestrian crossing was also provided at Bunbury Gate by the Operations Department in 2018.

	Transport objectives, proper planning, Oldtown/Mooretown Local Area Plan	It is an objective of the Oldtown/Mooretown Local Area Plan to deliver the Rathbeale Road Upgrade Project within the lifetime of the plan. Planning consent was achieved for the project at a meeting of the Council in November 2017. A detailed technical report was prepared with respect to the temporary road closure and diversion routes (attached below) which formed part of the Chief Executive's Report presented to the Council. The appointed contractor has made the application for a temporary road closure to the Operations Department of the Council under the relevant legislation.
	Access from housing estates during the diversion period.	Yellow box junction markings are being provided at the accesses to Sandford/Glen Ellan and Laurelton as there is deemed to be a future requirement due to queuing. No further yellow box junction markings are deemed required and the traffic signal sequence at the Rathbeale Road Junction is being amended to accommodate the diversion.
